I have compiled a complete registry of all businesses that have operated in the town and village of Lima. The information comes from several sources such as newspapers, the 1868 and 1892 Livingston County Directory, and old telephone books.

Lima House Photo Inventory

In 2015, I finished photographing the homes and business in Lima. There are now over 4000 photographs of Lima Village houses/buildings. (Some buildings have more than one photograph) This is incorporated into my database of buildings, houses, modern (current) house number, previous house numbers (pre - 1964) and various house "name" (former owners) directory.
