

Planning Board

The Town Board has asked to Planning Board to consider updating the Town/Village Comprehensive Plan which is now more than 5 years old. The Comprehensive Plan was written to allow future updates to selected sections without requiring a complete rewrite. The Planning Board has decided to review the Commercial/Industrial section of the Plan. A subcommittee of the Planning Board has been formed, but work has not yet begun. As progress is made, informational meetings and a final public review meeting will be scheduled before any changes are considered.

Work continues on the Lima Design Charrette that was held in October, 2013. Addition grant funding has been found to complete a detailed proposal of improvements to the Village that could include, signage, parking design, tree planting, general maintenance, and possible new construction that could include options for senior housing that was strongly mentioned in the Comprehensive Plan. The Rochester Regional Community Design Center is working with a steering committee of Village and Town Residents to develop draft proposals. A public information meeting and a final presentation will be scheduled later this Spring or Early Summer.
