

2015 Town Clerk's End-of-Year Report

Yearly Duties/Collections:

- Tax Collection: 2015 Total Tax Roll \$3,272,456.30
Breakdown-\$2,206,600.67 to County and \$1,065,855.63 to Town
- 310 dog license renewals for the year totaling \$2,347. Fees are \$8.00 a year for spayed/neutered and \$13.00 for any not spayed/neutered.
Breakdown-\$293.27 submitted to New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets to help animal population, \$1,022 paid to Livingston County Dog Control (\$3.50 per dog license renewal) and \$1031.73 are paid to the Supervisor for Town shares.
- Town Water collection for the 2015 year totaled: \$25,107.05
Breakdown-District #1 \$9,680.27, District #2 \$11,080.90 & District #3 \$4,345.88
- Total checks received and deposited from Building Inspector, Charlie Johnson, totaled \$7,228.44, from 44 permits.
- Department of Environmental Conservation hunting licenses totaled \$7,234 of which \$380.81 is commission paid to the Town of Lima.
- Marriage Licenses: 21 licenses issued. A fee of \$40 is charged per each marriage affidavit issued, of which \$22.50 is paid New York State Department of Health and \$17.50 is paid to the Town of Lima. Total of \$840.
- Issued 102 disabled parking tags. 78 Permanent tags and 24 Temporary tags. No fees are generated or payable to the Town.
- Clerk fees collected and totaled \$700 from 42 transactions.

Total monies handled and collected at the Town Clerk's Office total: \$41,934.91.
This does not include any tax monies collected January through March.

I also provide notary services free of charge throughout the year and attend yearly training through New York State Town Clerk's Association to maintain my RMC (Registered Municipal Clerk) designation. This year's training will be in Saratoga Springs, NY - April 17th-April 20th.
