BRUSH PICK-UP: will be during the week of July 16th. All brush (only brush will be picked up) must be cut in manageable lengths (no larger than 6" in diameter) and placed parallel to the roadside in neat piles before July 16th at 7:00 am. The village will only make one (1) trip down each street. The next brush pick-up will be the week of Sept. 17th. **Leaves will be picked up if placed in biodegradable bags only.**

FIRE HYDRANTS: Hydrants will be flushed the week of Sept. 10th from 7:30 am to 3:30 pm. Please excuse the inconvenience, as the water may be riley during this time.

FIREWORKS: The Village and Town are providing Fireworks on Wednesday, July 4th at Mark Tubbs Park starting at 9:45 pm.

WATER: The City of Rochester will be increasing its wholesale water rates by \$.05/1000 gals. effective July 1, 2012. Village water rates will increase by \$.05/1000 gals. and will be reflected in the October 2012 billing.

SUMMER RECREATION: the Program will run from June 25 to Aug. 2, 2012 (closed on July 4th) from 9 am to 3 pm, Monday – Friday and will take place on the Elim campus. Costs are as follows: Children (5-12) - \$150.00/child, teens (13-14) \$135.00/teen, additional \$100.00 fee for out-of-towners. WATER LEAKS: Check your toilets for leaks by putting a few drops of food coloring in the tank, watch for a few minutes to see if color shows up in the bowl. It is not uncommon to lose up to 100 gls. a day from one of these otherwise invisible leaks. Use your water meter to detect hidden leaks. Simply turn off all taps and water using appliances, then check the meter after 15 minutes. If it moved, you have a leak.

NOISE LAW: Our village code prohibits excessive noise, especially between 10 pm and 8 am. Loud or disturbing noise during these hours is a code violation. Please be considerate.

DOG LEASH LAW: Section 57-14-C states that a dog cannot deposit waste or commit a nuisance on private property, sidewalks, or in Mark Tubbs Park. Please pick up after your dog.

PESTICIDES: Please inform your neighbors when putting down lawn chemicals.
