### JUNE 2015 NEWSLETTER

**BRUSH PICK-UP:** will be during the week of July 20<sup>th</sup>. All brush (only brush will be picked up) must be cut in manageable lengths (no larger than 6" in diameter) and placed parallel to the roadside in neat piles before July 20<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 am. The village will only make one (1) trip down each street. The next brush pick-up will be the week of September 21<sup>st</sup>. Leaves, grass clippings, and walnuts will only be picked up if placed in biodegradable bags.

**FIRE HYDRANTS:** Hydrants will be flushed the week of September 7<sup>th</sup> from 7:30 am to 3:30 pm. Please excuse the inconvenience, as the water may be roily during this time.

**FIREWORKS:** The Village and Town are providing Fireworks on Saturday, July 4<sup>th</sup> at Mark Tubbs Park starting at 9:45 pm.

**CROSSROADS FESTIVAL:** The annual Crossroads Festival will be held on August 1<sup>st</sup>. Creeper Race to start at 12:30 pm and Bed Race to start at 1:00 pm.

**FARMER'S MARKET:** The Farmer's Market will open on Tuesday, June 16<sup>th</sup> on the Lima Presbyterian church lawn. Come join us every Tuesday from 3pm – 6pm. Co-sponsored by Lima Crossroads Council.

**DOG LEASH LAW:** Section 5-14-C states that a dog cannot deposit waste or commit a nuisance on private property, sidewalks, or in Mark Tubbs Park. Please pick up after your dog.

**PESTICIDES:** Please inform your neighbors when putting down lawn chemicals.

**LYME DISEASE:** During the summer season the ticks that spread Lyme Disease will be active again. It is advised to wear clothing that protects you from overgrown brush and tree branches when walking in wooded areas. Check yourself after walking and quickly remove any ticks you find – it takes about 24 hours for the tick to transmit the virus that causes Lyme Disease.
