MARCH 2014 NEWSLETTER

BRUSH PICK-UP: will be during the week of April 21st. All brush (only brush will be picked up) must be cut in manageable lengths (no larger than 6" in diameter) and placed parallel to the roadside in neat piles before Apr. 21st at 7:00 am. The village will only make one (1) trip down each street. The next brush pick-up will be the week of July 21st. Leaves will be picked up if placed in biodegradable bags. See more information on reverse.

FIRE HYDRANTS: Hydrants will be flushed the week of April 7th from 7:30 am to 3:30 pm. Please excuse the inconvenience, as the water may be riley during this time.

FIREWORKS: The Village and Town are providing Fireworks on Friday, July 4th, at Mark Tubbs Park starting at 9:45 pm.

PESTICIDES: Please inform your neighbors when putting down lawn chemicals.

BUILDING INSPECTOR: Only three (3) garage sales are allowed per address per year. Please remove your signs after your sale. Pool permits are required for all pools over 24 inches in height.

HFL SUMMER RECREATION: The camp will be located at HFL Manor School and bus transportation from and to the Lima Primary School will be available each day of the program. Camp will run from June 30, 2014 to Aug. 10, 2014. Children entering grades 1 – 8 are eligible to participate. The cost of the program will be \$300.00 per child for residents of Honeoye Falls, Lima and Mendon. SPRING CLEANUP: is May 17th and 18th. **Only two (2) pick-up loads per household.** Hazardous Waste, paint, tires, batteries, brush, refrigerators, air conditioners, computer monitors, wire fence and contractor debris will not be accepted. Collection on Friday, May 16th and Saturday, May 17th is from 8 am – 1pm at the village garage. Senior Citizens (65 years of age or older) can arrange for pick-up by calling the village office at 624-2210 by noon on May 14th and pick up will be on May 15th.

VILLAGE DATES – 2014

We schedule a **BRUSH PICK-UP** three (3) times a year. This year they are April 21-25, July 21-25 and September 22-26. Please have your brush out before **8:00 am on the Monday** morning beginning the week or you will miss pick up. Leaves, Walnuts and Grass Clippings will **NOT** be picked up unless in biodegradable paper bags. **Please do not put brush out except during brush pick-up weeks.**

Hydrant flushing is April 7th – 11th and September 8th – 12th.

VILLAGE CLEAN-UP DAYS will be May 16th and 17th from 8:00 am until 1:00 pm. at the Village Barns located at 7362 Dublin Ave.

Memorial Day Parade will be May 26th starting at 9:30 am.

July 4th Fireworks will be at Mark Tubbs Park at 9:45 pm.

Crossroads Festival will be August 2nd.

Scheduled **LEAF PICK-UP** begins around October 15th and ends November 21st or after the first snowfall. Once again walnuts will not be picked up unless in biodegradable bags. Also please do NOT put brush or debris in the leaf piles. We have found lumber, metal, large sticks as well as even a baseball bat in the piles. This will break the leaf machine and stop leaf pick up. If you do have some brush debris, put it in a separate pile next to the leaves and we will try to pick it up depending on available time.
