MARCH 2012 NEWSLETTER

BRUSH PICK-UP: will be during the week of April 19th. All brush (only brush will be picked up) must be cut into manageable lengths (no larger than 6" in diameter) and placed parallel to the roadside in neat piles before April 19th at 7:00 am. The village will only make one (1) trip down each street. The next brush pick-up will be the week of July 16th.

SPRING CLEAN UP: is May 18th and 19th. Only Lima village residents are allowed to participate. **Only two (2) pick-up loads per household.** Hazardous Waste, paint, tires, batteries, brush, refrigerators, air conditioners, computer monitors, wire fence and contractor debris will not be accepted. Collection on Friday, May 18 is from 8 am - 1 pm at the village garage. Collection on Saturday, May 19 is from 8 am - 1 pm at Shanks on Evergreen Street. Senior Citizens can arrange for pick-up by calling the village office at 624-2210 by noon on May 16th.

SUMMER HOURS: Beginning May 1st through Labor Day (Sept. 3) the village office will be open from 7 am to noon and from 1 pm to 3 pm on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Wednesdays from 9 am to noon.

PESTICIDES: Please inform your neighbors when putting down lawn chemicals.

FIRE HYDRANTS: Hydrants will be flushed twice a year from 7:30 am to 3:30 pm. This will take place the week of April 9th (weather permitting) and the second week in September. Please excuse the inconvenience, as the water may be riley during this time.

LIMA SUMMER RECREATION NEWS: Program dates are June 25th - August 2nd, program location yet to be confirmed. Fees are \$150 per child (5 -12 yr), \$135 per teen (13-14 yr) and \$100 additional per child for out of town residents. Registration dates are June 7th, 6:30 – 8:00 pm and June 9th 9:30 am – 11:30 am, Lima Town Hall. Registrations can also be dropped off or mailed to Lima Village Office.
