MARCH 2013 NEWSLETTER

BRUSH PICK-UP: will be during the week of April 15th. All brush (only brush will be picked up) must be cut into manageable lengths (no larger than 6" in diameter) and placed parallel to the roadside in neat piles **before** April 15th at 7:00 am. The village will only make one (1) trip down each street. The next brush pick-up will be the week of July 15th.

SPRING CLEAN UP: is May 17th and 18th. Only Lima village residents are allowed to participate. **Only two (2) pick-up loads per household.** Hazardous Waste, paint, tires, batteries, brush, refrigerators, air conditioners, computer monitors, wire fence and contractor debris or liquids will not be accepted. **NEW: Collection on Friday, May 17th and Saturday, May 18th** is from 8 am – 1 pm at the village garage only. Please do not go to Shanks. Senior Citizens (65 years or older) can arrange for pick-up by calling the village office at 624-2210 by noon on May 15th and pick up will be on May 16th.

VILLAGE OFFICE: The Village Office will no longer have summer hours. The office will be open from 8 am to noon and from 1 pm to 4 pm on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday; and Wednesdays from 9 am to noon year round.

PESTICIDES: Please inform your neighbors when putting down lawn chemicals.

FIRE HYDRANTS: Hydrants will be flushed twice a year from 7:30 am to 3:30 pm. This will take place the week of April 8th (weather permitting) and the second week in September. Please excuse the inconvenience, as the water may be riley during this time.

LIMA SUMMER RECREATION NEWS: The Village of Honeoye Falls, the Town of Mendon, and the Town and Village of Lima have united their recreation programs and partnered with HFL Community Programs to provide a new summer program called the HFL Summer Recreation Camp. It will run from June 28, 2013 – August 9, 2013 with the exception of the 4th of July. The camp will be located at HFL Manor School and bus transportation from and to the Lima Primary School will be available each day of the program. New features include: swimming every day (lessons and free swim), structured daily activities: sports, arts & crafts, performing arts, academic support, a nurse on site, and the ability to pay for camp with a credit card. For an extra fee the following are available: Lunches through HFL food service, new field trips, and wrap around care from 6:00 am – 9:00 am and 3:00 pm – 6:00 pm. Children entering grades 1 – 8 are eligible to participate. The cost of the program will be \$300.00 per child for residents of Honeoye Falls, Lima and Mendon. The cost for non-residents is \$450.00. Weekly enrollment is available for \$75./week and daily enrollment is available at \$20/day. Registration will begin in April.
