RE: TOWN OF LIMA PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY SURVEY & WORKSHOPS

Dear Resident, Business, or Property Owner:

Providing public water to parts of the Town of Lima has been a long-standing discussion of various Town Boards over the last few decades. This communication is intended to give you a brief overview of the most recent efforts to consider a public water project in the Town of Lima and current steps the Town Board is taking to receive valuable feedback from the community moving forward.


The Town Board has enlisted the assistance of the Livingston County Water and Sewer Authority to facilitate a public engagement process to obtain needed feedback for the Town Board to consider several water projects. A webpage www.lcwsa.us/town-of-lima has been dedicated to sharing information regarding several public water scenarios and seeking feedback from residents. The webpages include maps of the proposed project area, key facts regarding the process, anticipated costs, and some frequently asked questions.

In addition, a short survey has been developed for residents to complete. Both property owners and tenants are encouraged to complete the survey. The information obtained from the survey will be used by the Town Board to determine if public water should be pursued and what areas should be included. The survey is web based and can be accessed through the link or QR code below. 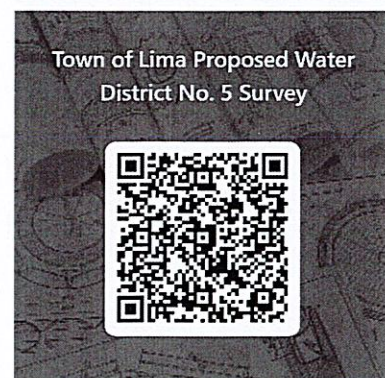

Workshops will be held on Wednesday, May 29, 2024 from 7:00pm – 9:00pm, and Saturday, June 15, 2024 from 9:00am -11:00am. Both meetings will be held at the Town of Lima Town Hall, 2nd Floor, located at 7329 East Main Street, Lima, NY.
