ARTICLE I. NAME

This organization shall be known as the Lima Golden Agers

ARTICLE II. The Club will bring together senior citizens or former senior citizens from the Lima Community for recreation, education, fellowship and cheer.

ARTICLE III. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section 1. The Club will be guided by a seven member Board of Directors which will include a President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer. Three additional Club members, one a former officer will serve on the Board.

Section 2. Members of the Board will be nominated by and voted on in January by the Club members. They will serve a one- year term and will be eligible for re-election.

Section 3. The Board shall fill all vacancies occurring during the year.

Section 4. It will be the duty of this Board to ensure all areas of the Club are run by the established rules of the Club; present new ideas and address complaints brought to them by Club members and elect a Citizen of the Year to represent Lima for the Livingston County Office of he Aging.

ARTICLE IV. OFFICERS

Section 1. It shall be the duty of the President to oversee all meetings; call special meetings of the Board; cancel meetings as need arises; establish committees as needed; establish a member list with names, addresses, phone numbers, e-mail information, and emergency phone numbers. Also to communicate with caterer, restaurant and speakers after the meetings.

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Section 2. It shall be the duty of the Vice-President to substitute for the President when necessary; make reservations for the meeting place; decide on the menu; take reservations from members; notify Club members with time and location of monthly meetings; share meeting information with the President.

Section 3. It shall be the duty of the Treasurer to receive all monies; pay all bills; keep an accurate account of income and debits; report income and debit information at the monthly meeting; deposit all revenue within (5) days of receipt.

Section 4. It shall be the duty of the Secretary to record the proceedings of the Board of Directors and the business portion of the monthly meetings of the Club; give minutes of meetings to the membership.

ARTICLE V. MEMBERSHIP

Section 1. The Club shall be open to anyone 55 years of age and older that is a current resident or has been a resident of the Town of Lima.

Membership dues are \$10.00 for new members from Jan 1st thru June 30th and new members are \$5.00 from July 1st thru Dec. 31st. Guests will be charged \$7.00 for the meal (up to 2 visits before deciding) but will not be charged the \$10.00 or \$5.00 dues until they decide to join. Only members in good standing will be allowed to attend meetings, vote, and hold office.

ARTICLE VI. MEETINGS:

Section 1. The Club will hold luncheon meetings on the 2nd Tuesday of each month. If a change is necessary, the President will inform the membership.

Section 2. At each meeting a fee of seven (7) dollars will be collected for the cost of the meal. The Town and Village will assist the Club with Budgeted monies.

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Section 3. Special meal requests or substitutions will be considered with prior notification.

Section 4. Monthly meeting locations will be announced a month in advance at the regularly scheduled meeting and in the Penny Saver.

Section 5. Members must make reservations if they plan to attend. Reservations must be made at previous meetings, or one week prior. Cancellations must be made 1 week prior to the meeting if possible.

Section 6. When monthly meetings are catered, excess food may be purchased. The price of this food will be determined by the Officers.

ARTICLE VII. COMMITTEES:

Section 1. The designated individual for the 50/50 drawings shall collect monies from the Club members who wish to participate; give out tickets; designate winners, (1/2 to the winner, 1/2 to the Club) give monies to the Treasurer; report names of winners to Secretary.

Section 2. The designated individual for the Sunshine Committee will send birthday, anniversary, get-well and sympathy cards to Club members; report these names to the Secretary.

Section 3. The designated TRIAD representative will attend monthly TRIAD meetings in Geneseo; inform membership of matters concerning senior safety.

Section 4. The designated Office of the Aging representative will attend , meetings in Mt.Morris, report information from these meetings to Club members.

Section 5. The designated Travel individual will present travel information to members; arrange day/ overnight trips with travel agents; finalize travel arrangements.

Section 6. The drawing (held at the Christmas meeting) for the accumulated yearly 50/50 tickets will be four(4) \$25 winners.
